- 6) Identify the Point of View of common interpretations of common symbols**

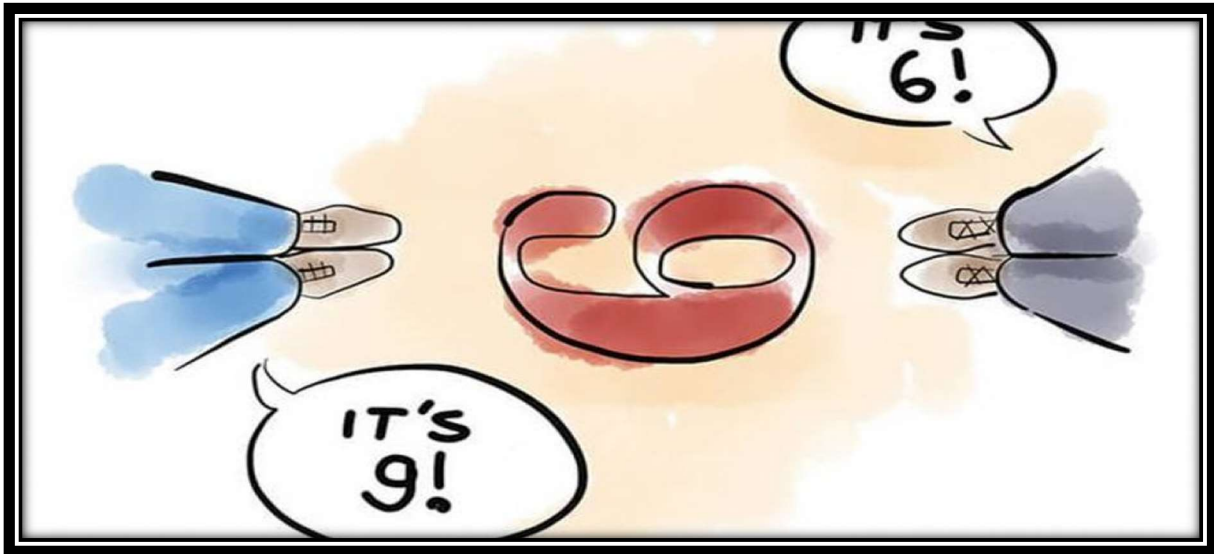
Point of View:

*The position from which something is observed;
A person's attitude or way of thinking about something.*

Context:

*The situation around a thing or event that helps explain or clarify it
The surrounding information or events that define something.*

Symbols often represent different things in different situations, or **contexts**. Different people can also see symbols differently, based on their **point of view**.
